	Pros:			
	 fairer awarding of ranking points 			
	Cons:			
	- arbitrary choice of 60 players?			
	- impact on player registration			
	behaviour uncertain, as the basis for			
	ranking points is then less well defined			
	- Risk of killing the weaker tournaments			
	Open points:			
	- should also apply to SWT & WC/EC?			
	- should also apply to upgrading a			
	tournament with lots of players?			
	- at what point is the number of players			
	counted? On entry deadline? On			
	issuing draws? On starting			
	tournament?			
	- will it lead to "gaming" (e.g. TD's			
	registering non-Elite players and then			
	withdrawing them)?			
	- Enforcement of doubles pairs to wear			
	at least the same colour (if not the			
	same make/design) shirt throughout (ie			
	not just when starting table tennis).			
	Justification is the image to sponsors			

	and live-streaming, and the easier			
	identification for referees. Penalty for			
	not changing shirt would be			
	disqualification. Difficult to police, as			
	multiple matches at same time, spread			
	across multiple courts. All present
