Email Text (from 23rd May):

We want to transfer the Treasurer function away from Amke.

This is an important and demanding position, so you will probably have seen our request to FIR country members, as well as our social media posts to attract the best possible candidate.

Following an in-depth discussion with Michael Gonnon, we are satisfied he is an excellent choice.
