## INTRODUCTION

The FIR Racketlon World Ranking is made on the basis of these regulations. The aim is to maintain a ranking system which adequately measures the players' achievements.

### 1. FIR-RANKINGS CALCULATED

The following Singles rankings are maintained by FIR:

- a) Men's Singles
- b) Women's Singles
- c) Men's Seniors (+40 / +45 / +50 / +55 / +60 / +65 / +70)
- d) Women's Seniors (+40 / +45 / +50 / +55)
- e) Boys Juniors (Under 21 / Under 18 / Under 16 / Under 14 / Under 12)
- f) Girls Juniors (Under 21 / Under 18 / Under 16 / Under 14 / Under 12)

The following Doubles rankings are maintained by FIR:

- a) Men's Doubles
- b) Women's Doubles
- c) Mixed Doubles
- d) Men's Seniors Doubles
- e) Women's Seniors Doubles
- f) Mixed Seniors Doubles
- g) Boys Juniors Doubles
- h) Girls Juniors Doubles
- i) Juniors Mixed Doubles

### 2. RANKING RELEVANT EVENTS

A player with a currently active FIR Player Licence earns ranking-points when entering and playing in a FIR Tournament as defined in the FIR Tournament Regulations, except for Team Events (FIR National Team Event and FIR Champions League), which are not eligible for FIR Ranking Points.

A Ranking Period defines the timespan for which tournaments count towards a player's World Ranking. Customarily, this is a rolling period of the previous 24 calendar months<sup>2</sup>.

The player's tournaments during the Ranking Period eligible for Ranking Points are

- two (2) best Challenger (CHA) and/or Satellite (SAT) tournaments and
- eight (8) best tournaments of the categories World Championships (WC), Super World Tour (SWT), International World Tour (IWT), Challenger and/or Satellite (but not including the two best Challengers/Satellites as above)

However, taking into consideration, that only the maximum number eligible for Ranking Points are:

- 1 World Championships (WC)
- 3 Super World Tour tournaments (SWT)

In case a player has played more than the above maximum number of WC/SWT tournaments within the Ranking Period, the best one (WC) resp. three tournaments (SWT) shall be taken into account.

### **3. RANKING SPECIFICS**

#### **3.1. Points Matrix**

The Ranking Points are rewarded according to the FIR Points Matrix (Annex A) as updated, amended and published by the Council of the FIR at the latest by January 1 of the relevant year.

#### **3.2. Minimum Draws**

FIR Ranking Points are only awarded if at least three players have taken part in the respective class.

#### **3.3. Multiple Entries**

If a player enters two classes in the same category (e.g. in Seniors' classes) only the class that has awarded more points will be taken into account for the ranking.

If a Senior player enters an open class (e.g. Women's B), then these ranking points will also count towards their Seniors ranking points. If a Senior player enters both an open class and a Seniors class, then only the best result will count.

A woman entering an Men's open event (e.g. Men's B), will be awarded only Men's ranking points for that result.

#### **3.4. Ranking carry-overs**

The year a player becomes 40 years of age he/she will also be ranked in the Seniors category. The ranking points earned in Men's or Women's classes will count, as is, for the Seniors ranking.

The year a player becomes 22 years of age he/she will be removed from the Junior's ranking and the points.

#### **3.5. Removal from the FIR Ranking**

A player is removed from the FIR Ranking if he has not played in a FIR World Tour event during the Ranking Period or on his request per E-mail to FIR.

#### **4.6 Ranking Nationality**

A player's Ranking Nationality is normally defined to be the same as the player's country of nationality, Players with multiple nationalities must choose which of the nationalities shall be used. This must be the same as the country a player chooses to represent at the FIR World Championships National Team Event.

For players whose country of nationality is not a FIR member, their place of residence shall be used as Ranking Nationality.

Players whose neither country of nationality nor country of residence is a FIR member are forbidden by FIR regulations<sup>3</sup> from participating at FIR international Racketlon events and so are excluded from the FIR World Ranking.

The Ranking Nationality is used in determining a country's "racketlon size", and hence also the number of votes assigned to them at the FIR AGM, in accordance with the FIR statutes 7.10.4. A country member may request that players assigned to them by way of residence shall not be counted towards their racketlon size if the player does not participate in their Racketlon activities.

#### **4. FIR RACE**

The FIR Race measures the most successful players on the FIR World Tour since 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year. There are singles 3 categories, each of which is split between men and women. There is no FIR Race for doubles categories or team events.

- Open
- Seniors +40
- Juniors u21

The FIR Race and the FIR World Ranking use the same points matrix.

Unlike World Ranking, only classes played in the relevant category count towards the FIR Race. i.e. playing a Seniors or Juniors class will not result in any points being awarded for the Open class. Similarly, a senior or junior playing an open class will not receive any points for it in the Seniors or Juniors Race.

Seniors or Juniors playing multiple classes (e.g. +40 and +45, or u21 and u18) only receive FIR Race points for the best result of the two.

A maximum of 8 tournaments count towards the FIR Race.

No more than 2 Satellite class tournaments count towards the FIR Race.

#### **5. PUBLICATION OF THE RANKINGS**

The FIR Ranking is published on the 1st day of each month and shall indicate the players' Ranking Nationalities.

#### **6. FINAL PROVISIONS**

##### **6.1. Coming into Force**

The FIR Ranking Regulations were passed at the FIR Founding Assembly on 2nd February 2019 in Vienna and last modified by the FIR Council on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and are valid immediately.

##### **6.2. Amendments and Modifications**

The FIR Ranking Regulations can only be amended and modified by the FIR Council.
